The scope also includes broad information about the coverage of the evaluation – but it does not deliniate boundaries such as whether the partnership underpinning the programme is within the scope, the modality of partnership, the performance of country offices, etc. Additional clarity on these boundary decisions would be helpful, as would a definitive list and definition of the evaluation criteria that were used.

While the mixed-methods utilisation-focused approach is appropriate, the report does not fully explain how the evidence was captured, processed and trianagulated; what the sampling frame was in each country (although the sample is described); or how the mentioned ethical standards were applied in concrete terms.
