Executive Feedback on PARAMETER 6	The recommendations section provides a number of recommendations relating to the programme and based upon the evaluation's findings but these are not based upon conclusions and there is no indication that the recommendations were developed in partnership with stakeholders. The recommendations made are relevant to the purposes of the evaluation and are all targeted to UN Women, rather than other stakeholders with no sense of prioritisation. All of the listed recommendations pertain to UN Women but it would have been useful for the recommendations to consider the actions of other stakeholders in achieving success of the programme.
