Cxecutive Feedback on PARAMETER 7 GEEW and HR is extensively integrated into the evaluation objectives and scope - from both a normative and programmatic perspective. The evaluation includes a comprehencive matrix of indicators that also capture both instrumental and transformative contributions. The evaluation includes a standalone criterion on GE?HR and mainstreams gender into all of the evaluation criteria through dedicated questions. While the evaluation adopts a largely qualitative design, it also includes innovative participatory and gender responsive approaches, especially Collaborative Outcomes Reporting Technique (CORT) – this ensures gender is included in both the process and the outputs of the evaluation. Findings address gender in terms of both structural and social-norms; at the institutional and the normative levels. These are carried through to the conclusions and recommendations.
