Executive Feedback on PARAMETER 7	GEEW is included across the specific objectives of the evaluation, and within the scope. No evaluation matrix of indicators beyond the results framework for the project is included. Questions relating to gender equality and human rioghts are explicitly included under each of the evaluation criteria. The evaluation adots a qualitative design and set of methods. These triangulate serveral different sources of data, including the voices of rights holders. Participatory approaches are primarily concerned with data collection; without a clear mechanism for supporting partilipation within the analysis stage. A gender analysis informs findings under all of the evaluation criteria; and this is continued through to the conclusions and recommendations sections.
