Executive Feedback on Overall Rating	evidence and can be used with confidence even though some information is missing and some improvement is required. Areas for improvement include: providing more information on how outputs are expected to lead to outcomes; the project budget; the reasons behind the selection of the evaluation scope and sample; and the reasons for the selection of evaluation criteria. Additionally, the report could be strengthened by using a data collection method that collects first-hand quantitative data; identifying unexpected findings; better balancing the project's strengths and weaknesses in the conclusions; providing more generalizable lessons learned; and ensuring that each recommendation is actionable.

Executive Feedback on Parameter 2	The report presents an overall clear and full description of the 'object' of the evaluation and is particularly strong at discussing the context in which the project is operating. However, some key information is missing, including: missing detail on how the project's outputs are expected to lead to outcomes; the project budget; and the role of key stakeholders in the project implementation.

Overall, the methodology used for the evaluation is well described and includes excellent information on data sources; the stakeholder consultation process; measures to ensure data quality (by including data collection tools in the annexes); how gender and human rights principles were considered; and how ethical behaviour was followed by the evaluation team. As regard to evaluation scope, the report does not specify areas that were not covered through the evaluation process, as well as there is no justification or criteria were provided around why a certain scope

Executive Feedback on Parameter 4	Findings are clearly presented, relevant, and based on evidence and sound analysis. They are structured around the evaluation criteria and provide a good description of the factors promoting or hindering the project's success. While gaps and caveats are referred to throughout the findings, the report does not explicitly identify any unexpected findings.

Executive Feedback on Parameter 5	Overall, the conclusions are clearly presented, based on the findings, and substantiated by evidence even though they tend to focus more on the project's strengths than the areas for improvement. Some lessons learned are over-specific and relate only to the evaluated object.

Executive Feedback on PARAMETER 6	The recommendations are relevant to the object and purpose of the evaluation and are clearly presented. They explicitly refer to the evidence supporting them and describe the process followed in developing them. However, the target group for action is not clearly stated for all of the recommendations, making some of them less actionable. Also, the 10 recommendations are not listed in order of priority.
