Executive Feedback on Overall Rating	This is a good quality evaluation report that can be used with confidence since it observes good practices in most of its sections. The elements that could be improved would be the following: the usage of data collection methods that can collect first-hand quantitative data; the inclusion of a section or subsection with clearly identified Lessons Learned; to include a description of the process by which the recommendations were produced, including the level of stakeholders' participation in it; and to clearly specify the way the methodology, methods and tools used in the evaluation included a gender-responsive approach as well as a human-rights approach.				
PARAMETER 1: OBJECT AND CONTEXT OF THE EVALUATION			PARAMETER 1	Good	
Executive Feedback on Parameter 2	The evaluation presents a very clear and complete description of the object of the evaluation. It includes a subsection on the Theory of Change that underlines the key inputs in terms of capacity building and awareness; particularly thorough information on the context in which the programme operated, and on the scale and importance of the object of evaluation in the region; the key stakeholders, including the strategic partnerships, and the project's implementation status.				
PARAMETER 2: PURPOSE, OBJECTIVES AND SCOPE			PARAMETER 2	Good	
Executive Feedback on Parameter 2	The evaluation's purpose, objectives and scope are thoroughly addressed in the evaluation report. The evaluation is particularly strong at clearly explaining the evaluation objectives and presenting the main evaluation questions and criteria along with a rationale for the choices made. Also, evaluation questions appropriately address gender and human rights perspectives which are also included in the evaluation objectives and scope.				
PARAMETER 3: METHODOLOGY			PARAMETER 3	Good	
Executive Feedback on Parameter 3	The methodology is clearly described and the rationale is discussed. Also, the report takes into consideration ethical safeguards as well as the mechanisms and measures implemented to ensure that the evaluation processes observed ethical standards, including the evaluator's obligations. The data sources and a list of people interviewed are available both under the methodology section and the annexes. However, the evaluation does not provide sufficient explicit information				

	to establish whether or not the methods employed are appropriate for analyzing gender and human rights issues identified in the evaluation scope. Additionally, the methodology did not use any data collection methods that could collect first-hand quantitative data, which makes the methodology overall light in terms of quantitative data.		
PARAMETER 4: FINDINGS		PARAMETER 4	Good
Executive Feedback on Parameter 4	The findings are relevant and clearly presented. The findings provide systematic analysis of what the evidence reveals in the context of the evaluation. Also, the findings are presented around the evaluation criteria and respond to the evaluation questions. Although, gaps and limitations in the data are duly addressed, unexpected findings are not discussed in the report.		
PARAMETER 5: CONCLUSIONS AND LESSONS LEARNED		PARAMETER 5	Satisfactory
Executive Feedback on Parameter 5	The conclusions are clearly presented, based on findings and provide added value and insight to the evidence presented in the Findings section. The conclusions provide straightforward solutions to important problems raised through the evaluation and discuss both strengths and weaknesses of the object of evaluation. On the other hand, Lessons learned are not included in the report.		
PARAMETER 6: RECOMMENDATIONS		PARAMETER 6	Good
Executive Feedback on PARAMETER 6	The recommendations are relevant to the object and purpose of the evaluation. They are supported by evidence; identify the target group for each recommendation; and reflect an understanding of the commissioning organization and potential constraints. However, although stakeholder participation is discussed in the methodology section, the report does not describe the process followed in developing the recommendations, including the level and type of consultation with stakeholders.		
PARAMETER 7: GENDER AND HUMAN RIGHTS		PARAMETER 7	Meets Requirements
Executive Feedback on PARAMETER 7	Gender and Human-Rights perspectives are integrated in almost all of the evaluation processes and sufficiently discussed in the report. However, it is not clearly stated in the methodology section if a gender-responsive evaluation approach was used, including specifically adapted methods and tools.		
PARAMETER 8: THE REPORT STRUCTURE		PARAMETER 8	Good
Executive Feedback on PARAMETER 8	The report is well structured, logical, and easy to follow. The title page and opening pages contain all necessary elements and so do the annexes, which greatly increase the credibility of the report. The executive summary can stand alone and inform decision-making.
